RESOLVED; that the Common Council of the City of Middletown hereby amends the City Code of Middletown Chapter 460 Vehicles and Traffic to remove the following from this chapter:

**Section 460-10 One way streets:**

King Street, between North Street and James Street, in a westerly direction

**Section 460-11 Through streets; stop streets; yield intersections**

King Street: King Street shall be a stop street in a westerly direction at the intersection with Center Street.

King Street: King Street shall be a stop street in a westerly direction at the intersection with James Street.

**Section 460-24 Truck Loading Zones**

King Street, on the northerly side in a westerly direction beginning 20 feet from the corner of North Street and running to 20 feet short of the stop sign at the entrance to the James Street parking lot (corner of Center Street).

**Section 460-8 Turns**

in King Street, between James Street and North Street;

**Section 460-13 No Stopping or Standing Area**

King Street.

- A. On both sides between North Street and James Street.
- B. On the southerly side from North Street to the James Street parking lot.

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED; that the Common Council of the City of Middletown authorizes the changing of King Street between Center and North Street from a one way street to a closed street for the King Street Walkway only available for emergency vehicles after the removable bollards are removed.

This resolution becomes effective immediately.
