RESOLVED; that the Common Council of the City of Middletown does hereby authorize the Commissioner of Public Works, and/or his designee, and the Chief of Police, and/or his designee, to close any and all streets and intersections necessary and at their discretion, for the Middletown-Walkkill Veterans Council, Memorial Day Services and Parade on Monday, May 29, 2017 for the laying of wreaths, rifle squad, and Taps will be in Thrall Park, Middletown at 9 a.m. The parade will step off at 10 a.m., up Wickham Avenue towards the Armory, Stopping at the Armory to place a wreath at the World War I Monument, turning onto Highland Avenue moving towards the Town of Walkkill Veterans Memorial Park for services, speakers, laying of wreaths, rifle squad, and Taps.

In the event of inclement weather, there will be no parade and the services will be held in The American Legion Post, 185 Wawayanda Ave. Middletown at 11:00 AM.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of Middletown approves the Memorial Day Services and Parade pending receipt and approval of the appropriate permits and insurance certificates by the Superintendent of Recreation and Parks.
