WHEREAS, the increased overnight parking of large vehicles in residential zones has generated a number of complaints from residents of the City of Middletown.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT Resolved, and be it Ordained, by the Common Council of the City of Middletown, New York, as follows:

Section 1. There is to be added to Chapter 460, Vehicles and Traffic, Article I, Traffic Regulations, of the Code of the City of Middletown a new Section 460-23.2, entitled "Overnight Parking Restrictions for Large Trucks" to read in its entirety as follows:

**Section 460-23.2 Overnight Parking Restrictions for Large Trucks**

It shall be unlawful to park any motorized vehicle equipped with over six (6) wheels on any street in any residential zoning district or on any street abutting a residential zoning during the hours from dusk to dawn. Persons who violate this Section are subject to a fine of \$150.00 for each violation. In addition, any vehicle violating this Section may be towed or removed or caused to be removed under the direction of the Police Department or the Commissioner of Public Works, without notice to the owner. The charge for such removal shall consist of the amount of all the expenses actually and necessarily incurred in effecting such removal. Such charges shall not exceed those

charges described in Chapter 440, Towing, in addition to any charges for storage. Such storage charges shall be in conformity with Chapter 440, and such amount shall be charged to the owner or person in charge of the subject vehicle. No vehicle shall be released until the owner or person in charge pays all towing and storage fees associated with the removal.

Section 2. Effective Date.

This Resolution and Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
