Whereas, the City of Middletown since 1998 has allowed electricians licensed by the City of Newburgh to perform electrical work in the City of Middletown on a job by job basis, and the City of Newburgh has reciprocated by allowing electricians licensed by the City of Middletown to perform electrical work in the City of Newburgh on a similar basis, and

Whereas, the Electrical Licensing Board has recommended that the same reciprocal arrangement be allowed for City of Port Jervis licensed electricians, and

Whereas, the Legislative Committee of the Common Council has recommended to the Common Council that reciprocity involving City of Newburgh and City of Port Jervis licensed electricians be codified in the existing Chapter 235 of the Code of the City of Middletown (entitled Electricians and Electrical Standards).

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Middletown that Section 235-5 (B) of the Code of the City of Middletown (Electricians and Electrical Standards) be amended by renumbering the existing Section 235-5 (B) (2) to Section 235-5 (B) (3) and by adding a new Section 235-5 (B) (2) to read as follows:

235-5 (B) (3) Electricians licensed by the City of Newburgh, New York and the City of Port Jervis, New York will be allowed to obtain a master electrician's license, Class B, upon payment of the fee set forth in Section 235-5 (B) (3). Such electricians shall be subject to the restrictions contained in Section 235-5 (B) (1).

Be it further resolved that this resolution shall take effect immediately.
