1. Chief Ewanciw requesting authorization to accept an award in the amount of \$11,792 given to us by the New York State Governor's Traffic Safety Committee for the use in the "Police Traffic Services" program effective October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019.

The purpose of this award is to increase seat belt usage and reduce aggressive, speeding, distracted and other dangerous driving behaviors in an effort to reduce serious injury or death from traffic crashes.

Upon approval, I am asking that the funding be added to our existing Police Traffic Services budget line A.3124.103.

2. The City of Middletown Police Department has been awarded \$3,800 to participate in the statewide "Child Passenger Safety" program effective October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019.

This grant money was given in an effort to increase the proper use and installation of child safety seats in New York State, and to cover the cost of recertification fees for our certified car seat Technicians/Officers.

Chief Ewanciw is requesting that this funding be added to the Child Passenger Safety budget line A.3189.450.

5. President Rodrigues is requesting approval for the donation of Engine One to the Hancock Fire Department once the unit is declared surplus.
6. J. Tawil is requesting approval of a proposal from Lehman & Getz and authorization for the Mayor to sign the agreement for Middletown Green Infrastructure. The costs are \$58,000 with funding to be determined.
