Overnight Parking Permits

1. City will issue a limited number of parking space permits. Each city parking lot number that allows for overnight parking, permits will be available through city clerk's office. Permits will be color coded by lot.
2. Permits are valid for calendar year. 6-month option is \$75, 12 month option is \$120. No refunds issued for permits and they are not transferable. A short-term permit issued at the discretion of the city clerk when there are less than two months to go before expiration. Fee will be \$10 per month, two-month maximum.
3. Permit application filed with city clerk's office.
4. Permits / Stickers required for display from vehicle. Placement is face out from rear view mirror or for hanging permits or rear driver side window for stickers as designated on the application.
5. Permits paid for in full prior to issuance.
6. Permits are lot specific and not interchangeable with other city lots.
