

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has proposed certain deletions from the three-hour parking limitations in the Business Improvement Zone.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT Resolved, and be it Ordained, by the Common Council of the City of Middletown, New York, as follows:

Section 1 – The Code of the City of Middletown, N.Y., Chapter 460, Vehicles and Traffic, is hereby amended by replacing Section 460.20.1 to read in its entirety as follows:

§ 460.20.1. Except as otherwise provided in this Article and in Subsection A, below, all streets in the Business Improvement District, as defined in Chapter 203 of this Code, shall be three-hour parking zones. No vehicle shall stand or be parked or be left standing or parked for more than 3 hours between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., Sunday through Saturday.

A. Excluded from this Section shall be:

1. East Main Street, on both sides between Williams Street, and East Avenue.
2. East Avenue on both sides between East Main Street and Fulton Street.
3. Roberts Street on both sides from North Street to East Main Street.

Section 2 - This resolution and ordinance shall take effect immediately.
