

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Police Chief is proposing an extension of the definition of “commercial vehicle” as it relates to the regulation and control of municipal parking lots.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT Resolved, and be it Ordained, by the Common Council of the City of Middletown, New York, as follows:

Section 1 – The Code of the City of Middletown, N.Y., Chapter 460, Vehicles and Traffic, is hereby amended by replacing the first paragraph of Section 460-9, Regulation and control of municipal parking lots, to read as follows:

§ 460-9. Regulation and control of municipal parking lots. No motorcycle, motor vehicle or vehicle shall stand, be left standing or park at any time in any parking lot described in this Section outside the time periods listed. With respect to timed parking spaces, moving from one parking space to another in the same parking lot does not extend the time limitations of such restriction. For the purpose of this Section, a “commercial vehicle” shall be any vehicle that has more than six (6) wheels or is longer than twenty-five (25) feet. The Department of Public Works shall install appropriate signage to implement the provisions and restrictions contained in this Section.

Section 2 - This resolution and ordinance shall take effect immediately.
